

# 2022 CUSTER COUNTY ASSESSMENT DATES

If you have purchased a home since 1-1-2021, you need to file a new homestead exemption. You **must** contact the assessor's office **before 3-15-2022**.

All businesses **must** contact the assessor's office **before March 15** to assess and provide an itemized list of assets on hand as of Jan 1st.

**ALL** farmers must contact the assessor's office **before March 15** to assess your farm equipment. To renew your farm sales tax exemption cards or for **NEW** farm sales tax card, go to: [OKTAP.tax.ok.gov](http://OKTAP.tax.ok.gov) or call our office for assistance.

Failure to assess prior to the **March 15th** deadline will result in penalties.

### DOUBLE HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION AND SENIOR FREEZE

Oklahoma Statutes allow additional exemptions for people meeting certain income and age requirements.

If your **GROSS** household income is:

**below \$60,800 and you are 65 or older** you may qualify for a 'Senior Freeze'

**below \$25,000** you may qualify for a double homestead exemption

**below \$12,000** you may qualify for a refund **IF** you are 65 or older or are disabled
