Miller, Member; Karen Fry, County Clerk; Sheriff Bruce Peoples; Michael Galloway, Emergency Management Director; Ronald Wright, County Extension Agent; Preston Brown; Brad Rennels, County Assessor; Wade Anders; District Attorney Dennis Smith; and Local News Representative(s).

The following Officer's Reports were examined and approved by the Board: Board of Prisoner's Report; County Clerk Report; Election Board Report; Court Clerk Report; Assessor Report; Health Department Report and Rural Convenience Report.

The allocation of alcoholic beverage tax for July, 2012 was approved for distribution by the Board of County Commissioners as certified by the County Treasurer: CUSTER - \$194.82; THOMAS - \$613.57; WEATHERFORD - \$5628.04; CLINTON - \$4692.90; BUTLER - \$149.11; and ARAPAHO - \$413.54.

The Board approved Sales Tax and Cash Fund Appropriations for the month of August, 2012.

The Board approved and authorized issuance of miscellaneous and blanket purchase orders.

The Board approved a Resolution removing the following equipment recorded in the County Clerk Fixed Asset Records from the T Hwy Cash, District #1 inventory: 2003 International Truck, VIN# 1HTMPAFM93H573937, ID # D-302-83, Original Cost - \$14,846.56.

Motion was made by Lyle K. Miller and seconded by Steve Tompkins to declare a burn ban for Custer County. Vote: Charles Hulett, Aye; Steve Tompkins, Aye; and Lyle K. Miller, Aye.

Motion was made by Lyle K. Miller and seconded by Steve Tompkins to accept 72 month lease from Kirby Smith for the purchase of a Hydraulic Excavator because it met all specified requirements and was a lower interest rate. Vote: Charles Hulett, Aye; Steve Tompkins, Aye; and Lyle K. Miller, Aye.

The Board approved the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of August 2012, the Board of County Commissioners of Custer County, Oklahoma, being in session, the following Resolution was adopted by the Board:

WHEREAS, upon motion made by Lyle K. Miller and seconded by Steve Tompkins and upon the vote of Chief Deputy Commissioner Charles Hulett, Aye, Steve Tompkins, Aye and Lyle K. Miller, Aye, this being a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners,

BE IT RESOLVED: The Custer County Board of County Commissioners agrees that Custer County has previously entered into to a Contract Agreement(s) with the Oklahoma Cooperative Circuit Engineering Districts Board (OCCEDB) for certain road and bridge construction projects, and

WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of County Commissioners borrowed from the Emergency Transportation Revolving Fund Program a total sum of \$755,000.00 that was approved on March 24, 2010 on behalf of District #1 for specific bridge projects to be constructed within said District #1; and

WHEREAS, the contract agreement states the anticipated construction dates and anticipated reimbursement dates for *each* specific identified bridge project as provided by the requesting County Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen circumstances the District #1 County Commissioner was not able to construct the scheduled projects as requested and satisfy the repayment of the loan as outlined in said agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of County Commissioners do hereby state their desire to satisfy the repayment of the remaining unpaid balance of \$322,572.87 owed to the OCCEDB; and

WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of County Commissioners do hereby direct funds in the amount of \$130,000.00 be deducted from the Custer County CBRI 105 District 1 Account and a partial payment of \$130,000.00 be submitted to the Office of State Finance; and

WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of County Commissioners do hereby direct amounts of \$45,000.00 each be deducted from funds of Custer County District #2 and District #3 as a partial payment of \$90,000.00 to be submitted to the Office of State Finance; and

WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of County Commissioners do hereby declare that Custer County District #2 and District #3 will take possession of bridge materials and/or other assets, purchased with District #1 funds and stored at the District #1 yard, equivalent to the monetary sum deducted from Custer County District #2 and Custer County District #3 accounts, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of County Commissioners do hereby direct that the Custer County CBRI 105 District 1 monthly allocation be submitted as a monthly partial payment to the Office of State Finance until the remaining balance of \$102,572.87 is repaid in full; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Resolution agreement hereinabove, and the same, is hereby approved this 6th day of August, 2012 by the Custer County Board of County Commissioners.

Motion was made by Steve Tompkins and seconded by Charles Hulett to approve an Agreement between Custer County District 1 and Custer County Districts 2 & 3 as follows:

WHEREAS, the aforementioned parties approved a Resolution determining the manner in which the Custer County Board of County Commissioners would satisfy funds borrowed from the Emergency Transportation Revolving Fund (ETR Fund) and owed to Oklahoma Cooperative Circuit Engineering Districts Board (OCCEDB) by CCD1; and

WHEREAS, CCD1 and CCD2-3 have agreed to act in cooperation to return the borrowed funds to OCCEDB as set forth in the aforementioned Resolution; and

WHEREAS, CCD2-3 agree to compensate CCD1 the sum of \$45,000.00 each into CCD1 Maintenance and Operation Account delegated as payment to funds borrowed from the ETR Fund by CCD1; and

WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of County Commissioners do hereby declare that CCD2-3 will take possession of bridge materials equivalent to the monetary sum mentioned above that have been accumulated by CCD1 and are presently stored at the CCD1 County Yard located in Arapaho, Oklahoma and are on the CCD1 Consumable Items Inventory; and

WHEREAS, attached to this Agreement are itemizations of the abovementioned bridge materials prepared by CCD2-3 and labeled *Consumable Items Inventory Transferred from Custer County District #1 to Custer County District #2* and *Consumable Items Inventory Transferred from Custer County District #1 to Custer County District #3*;

NOW, THEREFORE, this Agreement hereinabove, and the same, is hereby approved this 6th day of August, 2012. Vote: Charles Hulett, Aye; Steve Tompkins, Aye; and Lyle K. Miller, Aye.

Motion was made by Lyle K. Miller and seconded by Steve Tompkins to approve Emergency and Transportation Revolving Fund Renewal Contract as follows:

WHEREAS, the Custer County Board of County Commissioners has entered into a Contract Agreement with the Oklahoma Cooperative Circuit Engineering Districts Board for certain road

and bridge construction projects, and

WHEREAS, the expiration date of the following Contract Agreement is the 30th day of June, 2012, unless it is renewed in the manner provided in the said Contract Agreement, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Custer County Board of County Commissioners to extend the Contract Agreement for the following described project(s) and reason(s): Project Number: ETRCB7-20-3(14)11; Date Approved - May 25, 2011; Reason for Renewal - All 4 projects are completed. 3 of 4 payments are in transit and the other will be paid soon.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the aforesaid Contract Agreement be, and is hereby renewed to the 30th day of June, 2013. Vote: Charles Hulett, Aye; Steve Tompkins, Aye; and Lyle K. Miller, Aye.
