WHEREAS, the BIA and FHWA have suggested a change to rule 10 as published in Vol. 69, No 137 of Monday, July 19,2004 of the Federal Register, addressing the utilization of IRR funding restrictions to Tribal and BIA owned lands, would diminish a Great Native American State's participation in IRR fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVE by the Board of County Commissioners of Custer County that Custer County oppose the proposed changes to this rule, with the continued goal of provision of fairness for all Native Americans regardless of their State of residency.
