July 17, 2013

Michael Galloway opened the July 17, 2013 meeting.

Michael reviewed mapping tools, Google Earth and CAMEO software, that are available for first responders.

A statewide EOC full scale exercise called Earth, Wind & Fire will take place November 14, 2013 at the Frisco Center. Michael requested people from each ESF (Emergency Service Function) category be present.

Michael gave a tour of the EOC website. (Emergency Operations Center)

Attendees were reminded that NIMS Training ICS 300 and ICS 400 is available at Hobart, Oklahoma on August 3-4, 2013 and is necessary for command certification. (For information go to osufst.org)

Michael introduced Cher McGuirk, Region 1 Health Planner, with Ok State Dept of Health who works with Local Emergency Response Coordinators on all hazard preparedness. She spoke briefly and reminded attendees that hazard mitigation grants come from disasters and Notice of Intent needs to be approved. The dollar amount is derived from a federally declared disaster. Entities need to prepare a hazard mitigation grant. SWODA has applications for those grants. Michael clarified what entities are eligible for these grants.

Janna Harris with SWODA spoke about upcoming available funds for projects from the May 20, 2013 tornados; siting that an estimated \$6,000,000.00 has already been allotted for that disaster. Ms. Harris also notified the group there are new map books available through SWODA that include 911 addresses with the maps. (For maps call: 580 562 4882) She passed out handouts on the HMGP Applications in progress, the active FEMA declared disasters, and the SoonerSafe Rebate Program.

Michael discussed Blackboard Connect for government emergency messages.

Meeting was adjourned at 12:00 noon.
