

CUSTER COUNTY FLOODPLAIN BOARD MEETING



March 3, 2025

Randy Carpenter, Floodplain Board Chairman, called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Upon roll call the attendees were as follows: Debbie Bright, Randy Carpenter, James Friesen and Brett Brittain

There was no old business to come before the board.

Randy Carpenter

presented Floodplain Crossing Permit Application(s) as follows:

1. Nadel & Gussman / Canyon Oilfield, Construction, drilling, completing and production of an oil & gas well – From Hwy 33 & Hwy 34 (Hammon), go E. on 33 for 6.29 miles, N. into location, or From Hwy 33 & Hwy 44 (Butler), go W. on 33 for 4.76 miles, N. into locations in Section 31, T14N, R19WIM. Permit #2025-1.
2. Devon Energy Production Company L.P., Approximately 2 miles of gathering line for produced water will be buried at 72 in. below streams and at least 48 in. in all other areas of the floodplain – 3.5 miles west of Foss Reservoir just north of Hwy 73. Located in between Hwy 3 and E990 Road – Gadwall to Foghorn Gathering Pipeline Project. Permit #2025-2
3. Devon Energy Corporation, New oil/gas pad site in Section 26, Township 14N., Range 20WIM. Permit #2025-3

Following review and discussion, a motion was made by Brett Brittain and seconded by James Friesen to approve said permit application pending receipt of permit fee. Vote: Randy Carpenter, Aye; James Friesen, Aye; Brett Brittain, Aye.
