



CUSTER COUNTY LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

November 18, 2025

Custer County LEPC met in Special Session at the City of Weatherford City Hall, 522 W Rainey Ave., Weatherford, OK. The meeting was called to order by Hardy Sperle, LEPC Chairman at 3:00 p.m.

Mr. Sperle introduced Lauree Beth Marshall who has been working with him on updating Custer County's Emergency Operation Plan. Mrs. Marshall gave updates on what activities have been done prior to the meeting. Mrs. Marshall stated she has turned in the updated Emergency Operation Plan to the state but has not heard any feedback yet. Prior to Mr. Sperle's entrance as Custer County's Emergency Management Director, she worked on the Emergency Operation Plan with Michael Galloway who wanted to incorporate the use of "lifelines." She does not want to reinvent the wheel, therefore keeping the current emergency support function format and incorporating the lifelines within. Mrs. Marshall wanted input from the emergency support function partners as she read through the emergency support functions, concurrence list, and critical tasks.
