
Discussed training opportunities. October 21-27, 2023 there will be Red River Action Report held in Thackerville. Homeland Security will be doing training called radio 100 and radio 101. City of Weatherford has partnered up with Devon with the Stop the Bleed class. 7-20-23 from 6pm -10pm will be a staging class held in Watonga at the Emergency Response Center behind the Casino.

Mike is working on updating the Hazard Mitigation Plan

35 people have installed their safe room at 90% of cost. Still have 4 people in the works of getting theirs installed.

Foss Lake had 40-50 camp sites that were damaged, 1 cabin was damaged, a shipping container was laid over on its side and numerous trees down. Mike Karlin measured his tree pile 7-18-23 and it was 19 thousand cubic yards and they are still not finished with collecting limbs. Clinton tower has been placed back in service. We have met the threshold for the county FEMA, but have not met the State 7.2 million threshold. City of Clinton and Weatherford are asking for state help for the damages from the storm that occurred on 7-9-23. Mike Karlin stated over 1 million on just the debris pile and they are not near finished including Radar Park damages.
