The primary source for this fund was allocated but not limited to the Use Sales Tax receipts. The Board of Commissioners reserved the right to deposit funds from other sources they deem appropriate.

Beginning each July 1, 2026 monthly deposits from the Oklahoma Tax Commission resulting from Use Tax receipts shall be appropriated to the Custer County Rural Fire Truck Use Tax Fund limited to a maximum of \$150,000.00 for each Fiscal Year as the funds remain available.

The Board of County Commissioners determines that for simplification of accounting, when the Use Tax collections reaches the maximum amount of \$150,000.00, a purchase order will be written from the Custer County Rural Fire Truck Use Tax Fund to the respective Fire Department's Sales Tax Capital Outlay. Said amount will be utilized by the Fire Department for the purchase of fire trucks and equipment attaching to the fire truck and will be documented on the purchase order that funding was provided through the Custer County Rural Fire Truck Use Tax Fund.

6. If transferring Federal funds from the Official Depository account the Federal Account number will be noted on the voucher with the Assistance Listings Number, (formerly called CFDA number).
7. By July 31st, all Officers that have a Federal grant will file their SEFA (Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards) with the County Clerk, or office designated to compile the SEFA.
8. County Clerk, or office designated to compile the SEFA, will compile individual SEFA into one and verify the schedule with all supporting documents.
9. The SEFA and supporting documentation will be presented and approved in open meeting and reviewed by individuals signing the SEFA attesting to its accuracy.

ARTICLE II, PURPOSE

The parties hereto, through their respective governing bodies, hereby find and declare;

WHEREAS, Circuit Engineering Districts may provide assistance to county governments as provided by Title 69 O.S. 687.1; and

WHEREAS, Circuit Engineering District #7 has the authority to comply with and carry out the provisions of the Interlocal Act; and

WHEREAS, Custer County has the need for right of way acquisition assistance;

WHEREAS, Circuit Engineering District #7 has certified personnel and the expertise to provide needed services and reports required for the projects;

WHEREAS, Custer County’s total cost to Circuit Engineering District #7 for standard right of way acquisition of the bridge will not exceed \$7,771.00;
