Investments shall be deposited in certificates of deposits and/or money market accounts to draw interest with FDIC coverage. The County Treasurer will have full discretion in decisions concerning the investment of county funds and monies, but shall give due consideration to liquidity, diversification, safety of principal, yield, maturity, quality and capability of investment management, with primary emphasis on safety and liquidity.

The safe located in the office of the County Treasurer is designated as a safe and secure receptacle for safekeeping of all investments. *The safe deposit box(es) located at (list financial institutions) is/are designated as safe and secure receptacles for safekeeping of the investments.*
