**SCHOOL FURNITURE, FIXTURES AND EQUIPMENT AND ACQUIRING AND IMPROVING SCHOOL SITES RELATED TO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 5, CUSTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA ("ARAPAHO-BUTLER PUBLIC SCHOOLS" OR THE "DISTRICT"); ESTABLISH A RESERVE FUND, IF ANY, CAPITALIZE INTEREST AND PAY COSTS OF ISSUANCE; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING PURSUANT TO 60 O.S. SECTION 176(G); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Custer County Economic Development Authority, a public trust (the "Authority"), has been created by a Trust Indenture for the use and benefit of Custer County, Oklahoma (the "County"), under authority of and pursuant to the provisions of Title 60, Oklahoma Statutes 2021, Sections 176-180.4, inclusive, as amended and supplemented, the Oklahoma Trust Act and other applicable statutes of the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Authority have determined upon a financing plan consisting of providing funds to complete the acquisition, construction, equipping, renovating, and remodeling of school buildings, acquiring school furniture, fixtures and equipment and acquiring and improving school sites related to Independent School District No. 5, Custer County, Oklahoma ("Arapaho-Butler Public Schools" or the "District"); establish a reserve fund, if any, capitalize interest and pay costs of issuance; and

WHEREAS, in order to effect the said financing, the Trustees of the Authority intend to incur indebtedness in the aggregate principal par amount of not to exceed Four Million Five Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$4,500,000), said indebtedness to be evidenced by the issuance of lease revenue bonds, bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness, in one or more series on a tax-exempt or taxable basis, at a premium or discount (the "Bonds"), of the Authority pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in a Bond Indenture securing the Bonds (the "Indenture");

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CUSTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The aforesaid plan and the financing thereof, as submitted, will provide funds for the acquisition, construction, equipping, renovating and remodeling of school buildings, acquiring school furniture, fixtures and equipment and acquiring and improving school sites; establish a reserve fund, if any, capitalize interest and pay costs of issuance within Custer County, Oklahoma. The aforesaid project will serve the public purposes of the County and hereby is expressly determined to be in furtherance of the public purposes for which the Authority was created.

SECTION 2. The incurring of indebtedness by the Trustees of the Custer County Economic Development Authority (the "Authority") in the aggregate principal par amount of not to exceed Four Million Five Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$4,500,000) in one or more series on a tax-exempt or taxable basis, at a premium or discount (the "Bonds"), in order to provide funds for the acquisition, construction, equipping, renovating and remodeling of school buildings, acquiring school furniture, fixtures and equipment and acquiring and improving school sites; establish a reserve fund, if any, capitalize interest and pay costs of issuance, is hereby consented to, authorized and approved for and on behalf of the County, by the governing body of said County. Further, the County Commissioners hereby approve, by a two-thirds (2/3) or greater vote, the waiver of competitive bidding with regard to the sale of the Bonds to D.A. Davidson & Co. (the "Underwriter"). Competitive bidding upon the Bonds evidencing said indebtedness hereby is expressly waived, and negotiated sale of the Bonds evidencing said indebtedness to Underwriter is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to the requirement of 60 O.S. Section 176(F), the Board of County Commissioners of Custer County, Oklahoma, by a two-thirds (2/3) or greater vote, hereby approves and authorizes the incurring of indebtedness by the Custer County Economic Development Authority in a maximum aggregate principal par amount of up to Four Million Five Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$4,500,000) said indebtedness to be evidenced by the issuance of the Bonds of the Authority pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in a Bond Indenture

securing the Bonds, such Bonds being described and authorized by the Resolution of the Authority of November 17, 2025.

SECTION 4. By reason of the need for public buildings to be used as school facilities within Custer County, Oklahoma, and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.

SECTION 5. The County anticipates that the total amount of tax-exempt obligations (other than private activity bonds) issued by the County together with any subordinate entities will not exceed \$10,000,000 for calendar year 2025 and hereby designates the Obligations to be qualified tax-exempt obligations with respect to the financial institution interest deduction provisions contained in the Code ("bank qualified") and authorizes the Chairman or Vice Chairman and Secretary to execute and deliver on behalf of the County this Resolution which will constitute a Certificate of Designation to that effect.

SECTION 6. In all other respects all of the actions of the Authority taken on November 17, 2025, with respect to the issuance of the Bonds and otherwise are hereby and by these presents expressly approved, confirmed and ratified in all respects.
