

2018 CUSTER COUNTY ASSESSMENT DATES

If you have **purchased** a home since 1-1-2017 you need to file a new homestead exemption. You **must** contact the assessor's office **before 3-15-2018**.

All businesses must contact the office before March 15 to assess and provide an itemized list of assets on hand as of Jan 1st.

ALL farmers must contact the office **before March 15** to assess your farm equipment and to renew **farm sales tax exemption cards**.
Expired farm sales tax exempt cards now require a new application.

Failure to assess prior to the **March 15th deadline** will result in penalties.

DOUBLE HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION AND SENIOR FREEZE

Oklahoma Statutes allow additional exemptions for people meeting certain income and age requirements.

If your **GROSS** household income is:

below \$55,600 and you are 65 or older you may qualify for a 'Senior Freeze'

below \$20,000 you may qualify for a double homestead exemption

below \$12,000 you may qualify for a refund **IF** you are 65 or older or are disabled
