

ELECTION PROCLAMATION
AND NOTICE OF ELECTION

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 68, Oklahoma Statutes 2011, as amended, Section 1370-1372, inclusive and pursuant to a Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Custer County, Oklahoma, authorizing the calling of an election for the purposes hereinafter set forth, I, the undersigned, Lyle K. Miller, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Custer County, Oklahoma, hereby call a special election to be held on the 8th day of February, 2022, within said County of Custer, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of Custer County, Oklahoma, for their approval or rejection of the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

SHALL A PROPOSITION OF CUSTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, ENTITLED:

A PROPOSITION PROVIDING FOR FUNDS FOR CUSTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; LEVYING AND EXTENDING THE EXISTING FIVE (5) YEAR TEMPORARY SALES TAX OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (ONE-HALF CENT) TO BE LEVIED UPON THE GROSS PROCEEDS OR GROSS PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM ALL SALES OR SERVICES IN THE COUNTY UPON WHICH A CONSUMER'S SALES TAX IS LEVIED BY THIS STATE, COMMENCING ON THE 1ST DAY OF JULY, 2022, FOR FUNDING OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 50% FOR THE GENERAL COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF CUSTER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA.**

- 30% FOR THE CUSTER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE.**

- 8% FOR THE CUSTER COUNTY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION TO BE DIVIDED EQUALLY AMONG ARAPAHO, BUTLER, CLINTON, CUSTER CITY, THOMAS AND WEATHERFORD FIRE DEPARTMENTS.**

- 8% FOR THE OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY EXTENSION OFFICE.**

- 4% FOR THE CUSTER COUNTY FREE FAIR BOARD.**

BE APPROVED?

The ballot used at said election shall set out the proposition as above set forth, and shall also contain the words: TO VOTE, MARK YOUR CHOICE IN THE SPACE PROVIDED, LIKE THIS

_____ YES – FOR THE PROPOSITION

_____ NO – AGAINST THE PROPOSITION


If the voter desires to vote for the above proposition, he shall mark the choice "YES - FOR THE PROPOSITION". If he desires to vote against the above proposition, he shall mark the choice "NO - AGAINST THE PROPOSITION".

The polls shall be opened at 7:00 a.m. and remain open continuously and be closed at 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election.

The number and location of the polling places for said election shall be the same as the regular precinct polling places designated by the County Election Board, which officers shall also act as counters.

Returns of said election will be canvassed by the County Election Board of Custer County and results will be certified by said County Election Board to the County Commissioners through the County Clerk.


