



INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
No. 2026-05-18A

This Agreement is entered into this ^{19th} day of May, 2026, between the City of Clinton, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "CITY" and the Custer County, Oklahoma, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY." Together, CITY and COUNTY shall be referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, In June of 1959 the Oklahoma State Legislature and Oklahoma Department of Transportation made changes to the State Highway System, which included sections of US 66.

WHEREAS, the State specifically removed from the State Highway System the portion of US 66 which began, "at a point in Clinton at the intersection of 10th Street and Choctaw Ave and extending south and west a distance of 5.0 miles" (the "Removed Highway").

WHEREAS, the State returned the Removed Highway to the City and County for the purposes of maintenance.

WHEREAS, in 2001 and 2026, by Ordinance numbers 846 and 846a, the City of Clinton annexed land South of its then existing municipal limits, which included portions of the former US 66.

WHEREAS, the portion of the Removed Highway, between 28th Street in Clinton and Exit 62 on I-40 (the "Damaged Removed Highway"), has fallen into disrepair creating a risk of harm to the health, welfare and safety of the residents of Custer County and the traveling public.

WHEREAS, Route 66 turns 100 on November 11, 2026, with yearlong centennial celebrations throughout 2026 marking the 1926 establishment of the "Mother Road."

WHEREAS, major events are scheduled across all eight states from Chicago to California, with significant activities in Oklahoma, and specifically in Custer County, resulting in anticipated increases in traffic.

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton and Custer County are vested with the power to enter into Interlocal Agreements pursuant to Title 74, Section 1008 of the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, the City and County have a history of working together for the common benefit of its residents of Custer County when projects are for a public purpose.

WHEREAS, this project is for a public purpose due to the risk of harm to the health, welfare and safety of the residents of Custer County.

NOW THEREFORE:


The Commissioners of Custer County, Oklahoma and the City Council for The City of Clinton, Oklahoma agree as follow:

1. The City agrees that it will be responsible for any materials, labor, financial cost, and maintenance associated with the repair of identified portions of the Damaged Removed Highway, specifically the area known as Route 66 between N2240 and N2220 roads.
2. The County, in order to improve drainage and visibility, will provide equipment and labor associated with cleaning the ditches of trees, other vegetation, and dirt associated with the repair of identified portions of the Damaged Removed Highway, specifically the area known as Route 66 between N2240 and N2220 roads. Scope of work not to exceed costs as indicated in the attached "Exhibit A." See Exhibit A.
3. Said material, equipment, manpower and work shall be tendered within 45 days of execution of this agreement by both Parties and shall be concluded within 90 of execution of this agreement.
4. The City and County may continue to work together for the common benefit of the residents of Custer County and may agree to explore other projects that meet that common goal. In the event that other projects become necessary, a further Interlocal Agreement will be required.






