WHEREAS, the public must be confident in the efficiency and efficacy of the *organization*. To ensure Oklahomans have that certainty, and reduce government waste and increase accountability, as stated in the OKLAHOMA 2013 BUDGET under GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY;

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Custer County is a county government that will make the most efficient use of their posers by enabling them to cooperate with each other and other units of government on a basis of mutual advantage;

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Custer County is certain quality road and bridge construction can be accomplished using far less funds and time under the Board of County Commissioners' administration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Board of County Commissioners of Custer County support and request Oklahoma Statutes § 69-507 be amended to promulgate CIRB funds, administration, and plan development to each county for direct efficacy and accountability to efficiently serve the people in the State of Oklahoma.
