

**RESOLUTION
APPROVING INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Inter-local Cooperation Act of 74 O.S. § 1001, et seq. enables local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner and pursuant to forms of governmental organization that will accord best with geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities. The cooperating governmental units can, if they deem it necessary, create an entity to carry out the cooperative functions.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Custer County, Oklahoma desires to enter into an agreement with the Board of County Commissioners of Washita County, Oklahoma to purchase emulsion product suitable as patching material utilizing a patch truck. Custer County hereby agrees to purchase and Washita County agrees to sell said emulsion product based upon current Six Month Bid price per Washita County's awarded bid, as Seller.


