

**RESOLUTION
NO. 2021-05-17A**

A Resolution concerning funding pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the coronavirus COVID-19 disease to be a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a National Emergency; due to the COVID-19 virus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, the Governor of the State of Oklahoma declared an emergency caused by the impending threat of COVID-19 to the people of this state and the public's peace, health and safety; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the Custer County Board of Commissioners declared Custer County a disaster area, entitled to aid, relief and assistance and do hereby direct the implementation of the County Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's statewide emergency declaration has been renewed and extended numerous times; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Custer County Board of Commissioners to protect the health and safety of Custer County and its inhabitants, to preserve the peace, and to provide civil defense and emergency functions; and


WHEREAS, approval of this resolution is in the best interest of the residents of Custer County.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Custer County Board of Commissioners as follows:

- A. The County Treasurer is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete the request and funding process for the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.
- B. Pursuant to guidelines set forth by the Oklahoma State Auditors' Office, an account has been established for acceptance of funding from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.


