## **RESOLUTION No. 2021-08-16B**

The Board of Custer County Commissioners did, by Resolution No. 2014-02-10A, establish the Custer County Rural Fire Truck and Equipment Use Tax Fund. The intent of this fund was to provide a stable revenue stream to purchase trucks and equipment for rural fire service in Custer County. The primary source for this fund was allocated but not limited to the Use Sales Tax receipts. The Board of Commissioners reserved the right to deposit funds from other sources they deem appropriate.

Beginning each July 1, 2021 monthly deposits from the Oklahoma Tax Commission resulting from Use Tax receipts shall be appropriated to the Custer County Rural Fire Truck Use Tax Fund limited to a maximum of \$120,000.00 for each Fiscal Year as the funds remain available.

The Board of County Commissioners determines that for simplification of accounting, when the Use Tax collections reaches the maximum amount of \$120,000.00, a purchase order will be written from the Custer County Rural Fire Truck Use Tax Fund to the respective Fire Department's Sales Tax Capital Outlay. Said amount will be utilized by the Fire Department for the purchase of fire trucks and equipment attaching to the fire truck and will be documented on the purchase order that funding was provided through the Custer County Rural Fire Truck Use Tax Fund.

The Custer County Fire Departments will be in the following rotation – Weatherford, Arapaho, Butler, Thomas, Custer City and Clinton beginning FY 2022.

The Board of County Commissioners adopts this Resolution and reserves the right to change this Resolution as deemed necessary.
