

**RESOLUTION
NO. 2022-01-31A**

A Resolution concerning funding pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, also called the COVID-19 Stimulus Package became effective; and


WHEREAS the Custer County Board of Commissioners has had application from the Custer County Sheriff's office for expenditure from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds as follows:

1. Four 2WD Chevrolet Police Tahoe with upfitting in the amount of \$281,928.00
2. Four 4WD Chevrolet Police Tahoe with upfitting in the amount of \$294,332.00

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of County Commissioners move to accept funding request to provide Custer County Sheriff's office with eight (8) vehicles in the total quoted amount of \$576,260.00, and in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, 2 CFR Part 200, the Board of County Commissioners further move that funds for this expenditure are to be drawn from Custer County's American Rescue Plan Act Funds.


This Resolution is adopted in an open meeting of the Custer County Board of Commissioners, Arapaho, Oklahoma, on the 31st day of January, 2022.
