

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-07-08A
ROAD DAMAGE POLICY

WHEREAS, Custer County has jurisdiction over and maintains roads which are designated for county usage.

WHEREAS, in an ongoing effort to maintain safe, convenient roads for the driving public and to protect the roadway assets of Custer County, including signs, culverts, tin horns, and bridges the Custer County Board of County Commissioners institutes the following Road Damage Policy:

WHEREAS, Custer County will charge a one-time, per-incident administrative fee of \$500.00 for any damage deemed excessive by the County Commissioner. Additional damage fees are as follows:

- a. **Hot Mix / Asphalt Road:** Damage under 100 linear feet - \$20,000.00. For each additional 50 feet after that, \$9,500.00.
- b. **Chipseal Road:** Damage under 250 linear feet, \$5,500.00. For each additional 50 feet after that, \$1,050.00.
- c. **Gravel Road:** Damage under 250 linear feet, \$4,000.00. For each additional 50 feet after that, \$800.00.
- d. **Signs, Culverts, Tin Horns, and Bridges:** Actual costs involved in repairing or replacing the affected structure using Custer County employees, equipment, or qualified contractors. The County Commissioner will assess signs, culvert, and tin horn damage. The County Commissioner will determine the bridge damage assessment and recommended repair procedures with the assistance of Circuit Engineering District 7 engineers and bridge inspectors.

WHEREAS, once assessed, all fees will be payable upon receipt. If no paid within 30 days, the County will assess a penalty of \$250.00 per day and pursue legal action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Custer County does adopt the Road Damage Policy as directed.
