Resolution Authorizing Application of Opioid Abatement Project Funding

WHEREAS, Custer County recognizes the ongoing impact of the opioid crisis on individuals and communities, and is committed to addressing substance use disorders and supporting recovery efforts; and

WHEREAS, funds for opioid abatement projects are available for three years beginning in Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) to assist with prevention, treatment, recovery, and related initiatives that mitigate the impact of the opioid crisis; and

WHEREAS, Custer County has identified the Oklahoma Alliance of Recovery Resources, Inc. (OKARR) as the project administrator to oversee the development and implementation of this initiative working collaboratively with community partners; and

WHEREAS, Custer County is committed to collaborating with OKARR to ensure the successful execution of the project and compliance with all funding requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Custer County, through its designated representatives, is authorized to prepare and submit this application for opioid abatement project funding, with OKARR serving as the project administrator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Custer County Board of County Commissioners is authorized to execute all necessary agreements, provide required documentation, and take any additional steps necessary to secure and implement the funding for this initiative as created by Title 74, sections 30.3 through 30.8.
